Prologue -They Risked Their Lives to Speak

They've been radicalized and battle hardened. They know what it feels like to decapitate a fellow human. They've seen women and children strap on vests and blow themselves up for the cause. And they've risked their lives to escape.

ISIS Defectors: Inside Stories of the Terrorist Caliphate breaks new ground, detailing the stories and reflections of dozens of men, women and even children who joined the ISIS jihad, but became so disgusted and disillusioned, they defected.

With unprecedented access, from September 2015 to May 2016, the ISIS Defectors Interview Project conducted in-depth interviews that include thirty Syrian ISIS defectors who successfully escaped ISIS and are currently hiding out in Turkey (fighters, wives of ISIS fighters, and even children who joined ISIS); two European returnees whose defections are unclear; six parents of Europeans who went to Syria to fight--some are still alive and inside ISIS and some are dead.

Each in-depth interview (some that took up to five hours) is a window into ISIS reality in full-living horror. From motivations to joining; the manipulation of children and their use as suicide bombers; the treatment of women; ISIS' sex trade; finances through seizures, taxation, oil sales and sex slaves; unexpected allegiances among political enemies; the killing of Sunni Muslims; mental health consequences and more, we have gathered stories, photos, and videos that are remarkably consistent and have never been seen before now.

ISIS is the most powerful, ruthless and well-funded terrorist group in recent history. Since its 2014 claim of establishing a "Caliphate", ISIS has unleashed an unprecedented and prolific social media recruiting drive that has attracted up to 30,000 foreign fighters from more than one hundred countries--at times drawing a flow of 1500 foreign fighters per month.

Both the CIA Director, John Brennan, and former Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA) Director, LTG Mike Flynn, warned after the deadly 2015 Paris attacks that these brutal killings were a sign of things to come. FBI director, James Comey, has confirmed that there are over one thousand active ISIS investigations in the U.S., across all fifty states. Though it appears that ISIS did not directly command the San Bernardino, California terrorist killers, one of them had pledged her bayat (allegiance) to ISIS before carrying out their attack. We know that ISIS orchestrated the Paris and Brussels bombings, and inspired the Orlando dance club massacre, attacks that occurred during the time we were conducting our interviews.

While a political solution in the war-torn area of Syria and Iraq is a necessary precondition to the total defeat of ISIS, given the nature of the proxy war that ISIS represents, and the complex web of regional actors that profit from the actions of ISIS, that's not a likely outcome in the near future. Military actions can degrade the group and its ability to recruit and finance itself, but ISIS is so embedded in civilian areas that the collateral damage of military strikes will likely fuel more terrorism rather than curb it. And it will send terrorist cells underground.

Thus, discrediting the group's ideology is essential to stopping its online recruitment.

We believe that disillusioned ISIS defectors who tell their authentic stories about life inside the Islamic State are the most influential tool to counter ISIS' robust propaganda and prevent others from joining. ISIS produces thousands of slick recruiting videos, memes and tweets. For this reason, most of our interviews have been recorded on broadcast quality video with the interviewee's permission. We are packaging these into short video clips, memes, written and audio stories to feed onto the Internet and social media, to counter and compete head-on with ISIS's successful and (as of yet) unchallenged online campaign. Some of the photos and links to our video clips are included in this book. More can be found at the International Center for the Study of Violent Extremism's website, ICSVE.org. (We warn you, some are very graphic.)

The defectors undertook a gravely dangerous journey to defect from ISIS and most have risked their lives to speak to us. All have willingly given us cautionary statements for Westerners and others who might be considering joining ISIS. We will use these statements, alongside their first-person accounts of life inside ISIS, to discredit the terrorist group from the inside.

For our part, this work did not come without its own dangers to us--from personal threats from ISIS inside southern Turkey where the bulk of these interviews took place to narrowly missing ISIS attacks in Belgium.

We are not journalists. We are academics and security experts, with additional expertise in psychology and law enforcement. We have published scientific papers and written books on terrorism primarily for scholarly consumption (many of which can be found on our website). This project and resulting book and videos, partly self-funded and partly funded by a donor who wishes to remain anonymous, are meant to be both useful to scholars as well as accessible to general readers.

ISIS Defectors: Inside Stories of the Terrorist Caliphate is a true life narrative of our journey, and the face-to-face meetings with those who have been inside the most brutal terrorist group in recent history. We have changed the names of all those who need to hide their identities, and withheld or changed identifying information to prevent ISIS from hunting them down for revenge. Though edited to avoid redundancy, we were struck by the remarkably consistent interview answers and information provided throughout the thirty-two defector interviews. As a trauma psychologist, I also saw clear posttraumatic reactions to recalling events they lived under ISIS.
