Basing her work on a research questionnaire and in-depth interviews, journalist Lott seeks to explore the therapeutic relationship from the patient's point of view. In traditional Freudian theory, the patient essentially relives early important relationships in a healthier way. The therapist's role is to be a neutral but supportive "projection screen," able to encourage clients to discuss strong feelings without encouraging or suppressing emotions ranging from love to anger. Lott finds that most therapists are not able to walk this fine line, either becoming entangled in their patients' emotional dramas or refusing to allow any discussion of the relationship. Nor do training programs offer much advice. Pressure from insurance companies is making the kind of in-depth therapy described in the book increasingly rare, a development Lott discusses in her final chapter.
